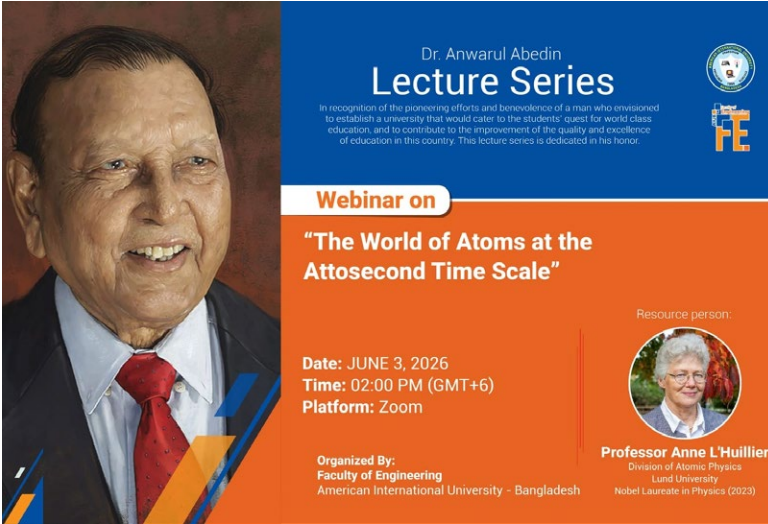

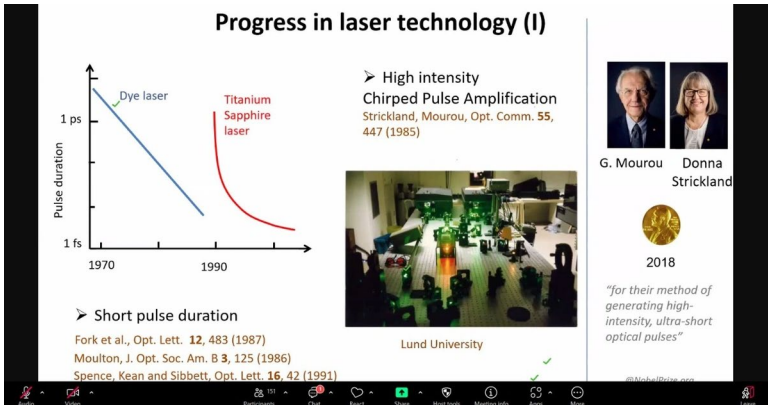

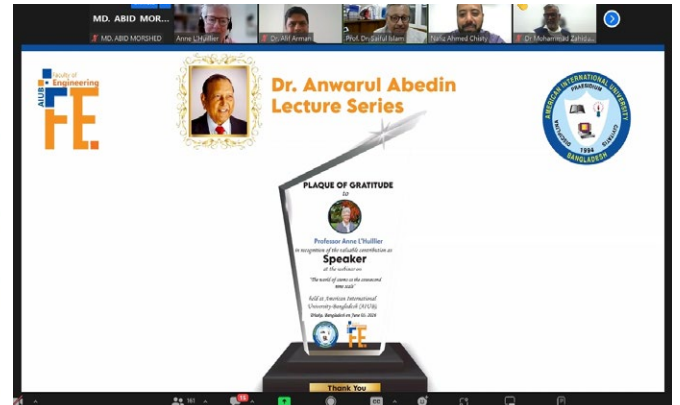

On June 3, 2026, Faculty of Engineering (FE), AIUB, organized Dr. Anwarul Abedin Lecture Series titled "The World of Atoms at the Attosecond Time Scale" in the form of a webinar. The webinar featured Dr. Anne L'Huillier (Professor of Atomic Physics, Lund University, Sweden), the renowned French-Swedish physicist and recipient of the 2023 Nobel Prize in Physics, as the keynote speaker. The webinar attracted a large audience comprising faculty members, researchers, students,

and science enthusiasts. During her presentation, she introduced the fascinating world of attosecond physics and explained how attosecond pulses of light can be used to observe and measure the motion of electrons within atoms and molecules.

Prof. Dr. ABM Siddique Hossain, Dean, FE, delivered the welcome speech. The event concluded with closing remarks by Prof. Dr. Saiful Islam, Vice Chancellor.

Lamagna and Ms. Dulce Lamagna attended a fireside chat with Professor Yang O-bong, President of Jeonbuk National University (JBNU), Republic of Korea, on the practical implementation of artificial intelligence in higher education, on June 3, 2026.

The session highlighted JBNU's institution-wide AI transformation, particularly its AI Tutor platform, which offers personalized academic support, real-time translation, lecture recording, and improved accessibility

for students, especially international learners. Professor Yang stressed the importance of faculty adoption and institutional support for successful AI integration in classrooms.

Another key innovation discussed was JBNU's AI Job platform, which connects students' academic experiences, skills, and interests with career opportunities. Using a global database of roughly 20,000 companies, the platform supports career planning, employability, and helps students select suitable academic majors.

The speakers highlighted the importance of measuring learning initiatives through business impact and performance outcomes rather than solely through participation and engagement metrics.

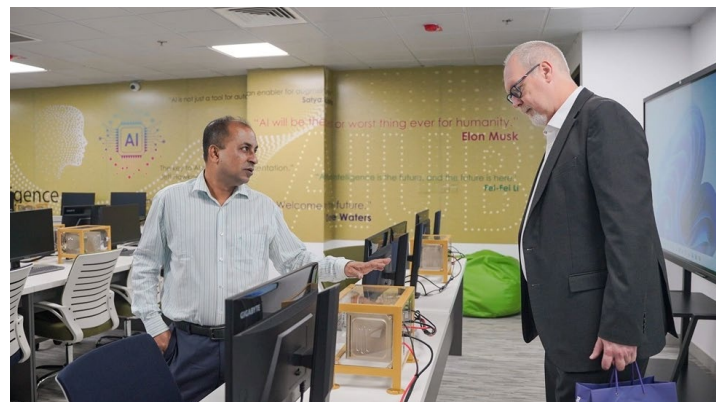
The Freshman Orientation for Summer 2025–2026 was held on June 6, 2026, welcoming newly admitted students, parents, and guardians.

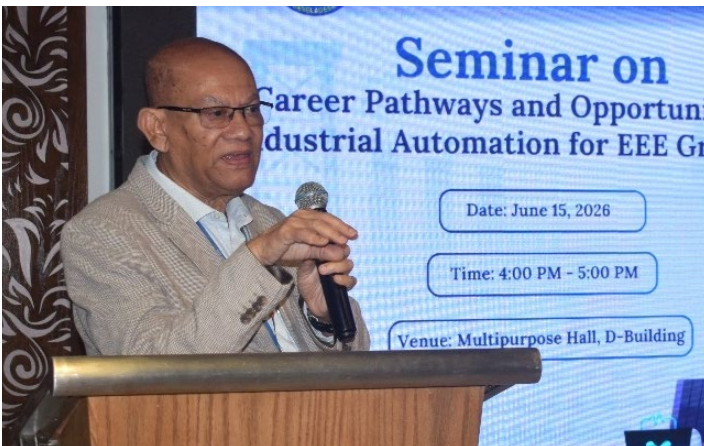

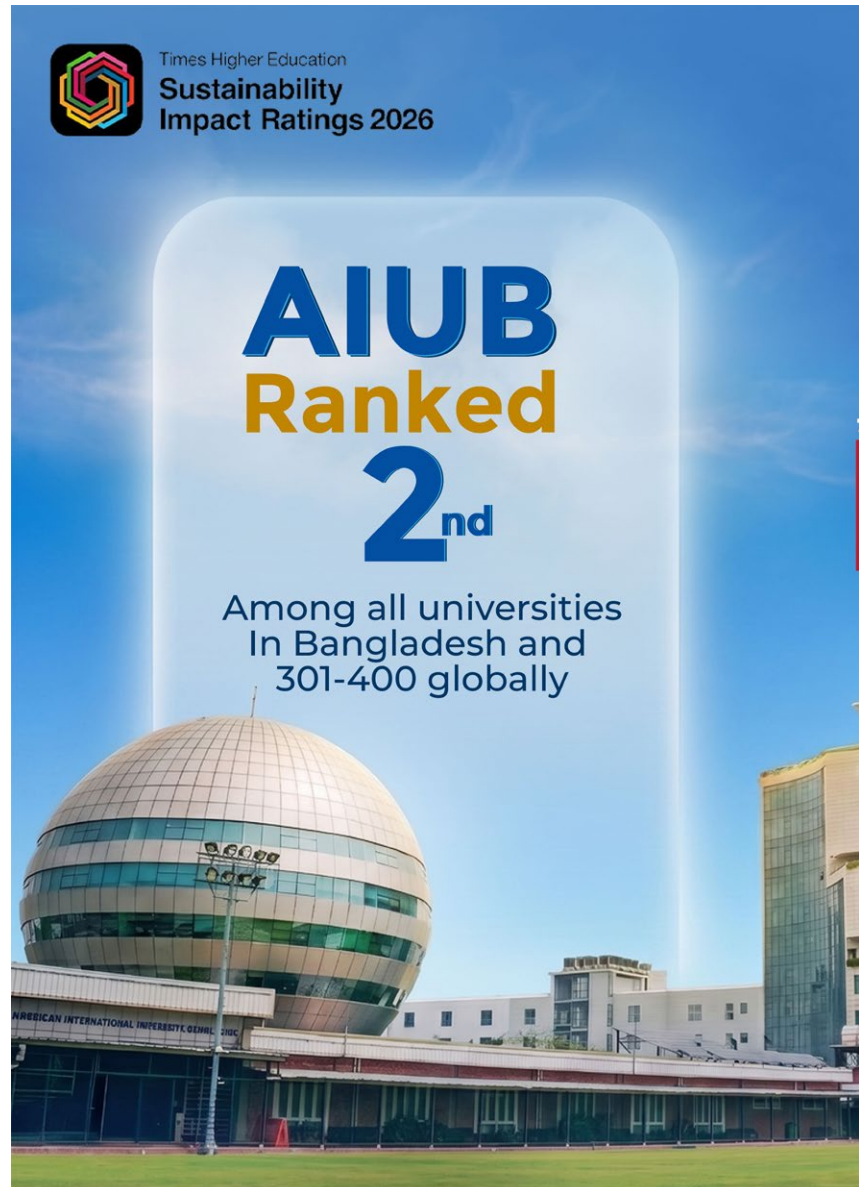
AIUB Retains 2nd Position in Bangladesh in Times Higher Education (THE) Sustainability Impact Ratings 2026

The THE Sustainability Impact Ratings evaluate universities' contributions to society through education, research, sustainability, and partnerships, measuring performance against the UN's 17 SDGs. AIUB FST Student Earns Best Oral Presenter Recognition at EFAST-2026 for Climate-Agriculture Research



Saturday-Sunday, June 27-28, 2026

AIUB's faculty-supervised student research team won the Best Oral Presenter Award (Track: Geography, Environment and Sustainable Development) at the International Conference on Emerging Frontiers in Advanced Sciences and Technologies 2026 (EFAST 2026), organized by Pabna University of Science & Technology (PUST) and Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP), held 27-28 June 2026.

The award-winning research, "Linking Climate Change to Crop Production Trends in Bangladesh: A Data-Driven Assessment of Agricultural Sustainability (1981-

2023)," was supervised by Md. Mortuza Ahmmed, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, and presented by Shahriar Sadib. The study examined climate variability and agricultural productivity over 43 years using NASA POWER API and FAOSTAT data covering ten major crops, finding rising temperatures and evapotranspiration as primary yield drivers, and recommending heat-tolerant crop varieties and evapotranspiration-based irrigation.

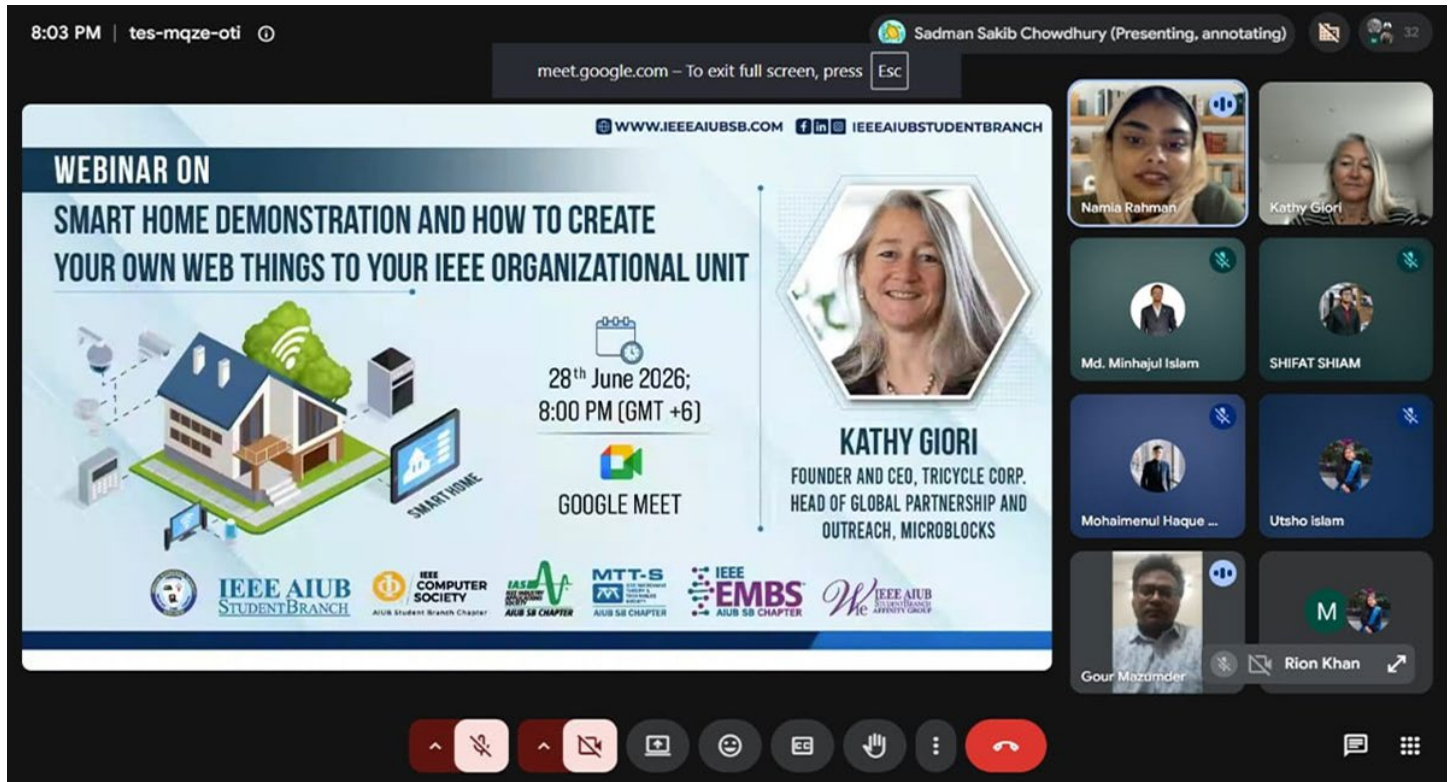
